1 About Excel Online

- Excel Online is the web-based version of Microsoft Excel, part of the Microsoft Office Online suite of applications.
- 2. It allows users to create, edit, and collaborate on Excel spreadsheets using a web browser.
- Excel Online is a cloud-based service that is accessible through a web browser, such as
 Microsoft Edge, Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, or Safari.

2 Key Features of Excel Online
